The Chairman thanked all the Councillors for their support and hard work, our District Councillor Mr Pallister and County Councillor Mr Fysh and the Clerk for her hard work and timeless support to keep the Council operating.

The Chairman finished by asking parishioners to consider putting themselves forward for the next Parish Council elections in May 2015. A copy of the full report is on file.

5. Public Question Time; i) In response to a query about drains the meeting was informed that the bus stop drain is about to be jetted and that the drain in Forge Lane is not SCC responsibility. This matter is being pursued with SCC as this drain is also collecting water from Weston Street. Cllr Mrs Carter to discuss with the parishioner outside of the meeting.
ii) In answer to the question who has paid for the traffic islands - Somerset County Council.
