    - Taking powers *away* from Taunton, and bringing them closer to the areas they affect, is the way to make Somerset stronger than it is now
    - On the other hand, centralising power and handing it over to fewer councillors/officers in Taunton will be bad for our rural area and result in worse services
    - A recent IPSOS MORI poll clearly showed the 2 unitary option was more popular amongst residents
- The Zwings e-scooter trial is now in Crewkerne (and Chard)! Users need to download the Zwings app, as well as hold a driving license. It costs £1 to unlock a scooter, then you pay 15p per mile. More details can be found <u>here</u>
- Help with Council Tax. Council Tax bills have been hitting door mats across the district. South Somerset DC is one of the few councils in the country that offers a 100% discount to the most hard-up.
