## District Councillor Report to East Chinnock PC, Nov 2021

## **District Council News**

- South Somerset District Council (SSDC) has joined UK100 a coalition of Local
  Authority leaders in the UK who are committed to achieving Net Zero further and
  faster than national targets. I helped draft the motion with Councillor Sarah Dyke,
  who proposed it at October's Full Council meeting where it achieved unanimous
  support. SSDC joins 112 local authorities who have already taken the UK100 pledge.
- Yeovil's MP votes AGAINST plans to stop raw sewage being dumped in our rivers. You might remember my item a couple of months ago about raw sewage overflowing into our rivers. As you know, this problem affects East Chinnock very badly. The Storm Sewer Overflow spilled for 1,081 hours (45 days) in 2020. This makes it the 5th worst Storm Sewer Overflow in the Yeovil Constituency (Tatworth comes 1st with 2901 hours of spill). In any case, the issue of sewage in our rivers has been in the press a lot over the last couple of weeks. The Government has now U-Turned, and promised to take action, but they are yet to publish any detail on how they plan to tackle this problem.
- Have you considered applying for an SSDC environment grant? Our Community
  Grant Scheme funds up to 50% of the application costs and requests between £101
  and £12,500 can be considered. Even a few hundred pounds for your community can
  make a difference to projects that benefit the environment and reduce the carbon
  footprint of communities. Find out more here
