• Latest message from Public Health (Fri 1/10/21)

"Covid-19 case rates in educational settings remain on the increase across Somerset and the South-West, with the majority of cases in the five to 18-year age group representing 60 percent of all Somerset cases at present.

It therefore remains extremely important for children over the age of 11 who attend school or college, along with their parents or carers and school staff, to do a lateral flow test twice a week to help prevent the unwitting spread of Covid-19 in educational settings.
